DOCTOR OF MUSICAL ARTS IN MUSIC EDUCATION

PURPOSE: To provide advanced training and research skills in music education, and to prepare students for a career in teaching music education at the collegiate level or in leadership positions in public or private schools.

MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Master's degree in music.
2. Minimum GPA of 3.00 for all graduate work attempted.
3. Submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores (as applicable) that meet University of Houston minimum standards.
4. Minimum three years of successful professional public/private school teaching experience.

MINOR FIELD: Student shall, in consultation with their doctoral committee and the Graduate Advisor, declare a minor field, consisting of 12 credit hours approved by the committee and the coordinator of the minor field area.

COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT: Students must pass a comprehensive examination in order to gain admission to candidacy.
