Historical Dates

- May 1960 Committee to coordinate a program in biophysics appointed by Dean Neumann
- Fall 1960 Executive Council authorized graduate program to be effective Fall 1961 and to be administered by an inter-departmental committee
- Spring 1961 Dean's conference approved undergraduate Program in Biophysical Sciences
- Fall 1961 Graduate Council approved graduate degree requirements for Biophysical Sciences
- Spring 1963 Program in Biophysical Sciences approved by Texas Commission on Higher Education
- Fall 1967 Department of Biophysical Sciences authorized by the Texas College and University System Coordinating Board
- Spring 1968 Sponsored national symposium on Proteins and Nucleic Acids: Their Synthesis, Structure and Evolution; Professor Oró, Chairman
- Fall 1968 First courses offered by the department
- Spring 1969 Departmental facilities become available in the Science & Research Building
- Spring 1969 53 undergraduate and graduate majors enrolled
