Job Description	<p>The Community Health Worker (CHW) will be working in the Division of Pediatrics- Public Health on a 1- year research grant to test the effectiveness of a tool called the Family CARE Portfolio. The Family CARE Portfolio is an organizational, executive functioning tool designed to help families: Coordinate care, Advocate for themselves, Record important information & feel Empowered to take charge of their health and well-being. This study will be evaluating it's effectiveness among CHWS with pregnant/postpartum populations. The CHW will recruit participants from a clinic and assist them with care coordination and accessing community resources.</p> <p>Job Duties</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 70% - Direct Service: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Helps participants connect with resources in their area and assists with applications for eligible programs. ○ Documents all activities, service plans, and results. ○ Maintains confidentiality per HIPAA guidelines in regards to patient information. • 15% - Recruitment & Consent: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Recruits families from target clinic. ○ Explains the study and assists families during the consenting process. • 10% - Research Activities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Collects research data and enters the data into the research databases. ○ Attends research meetings. • 5% - Community Outreach: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Develops relationships with community organizations and facilitates a warm hand off to families.
